RESEARCH INTO WORKPLACE HARASSMENT**

We are looking for volunteers to take part in a study that uses theatre-based methods to explore workplace harassment experienced by health care workers within the Saskatchewan Health Care Region.

As a participant in this study, you will participate in 5 virtual workshops (each to run 1.5 hours) in a group of approximately 10 front line health care workers, such as LPNs and CCAs.

The workshops, facilitated by artists from *Mixed Company Theatre—Theatre for Social Change*, will use theatre-inspired techniques to create and discuss multi-character scenarios depicting workplace harassment as it may be experienced by those who are subjected to it, those who perpetrate it, and those who witness it. Individual experiences will be kept confidential and all results of the study will be anonymous.
