DETAILS

The camp will begin Friday afternoon, August 5th, and end the following Thursday morning, August 11th.

Staff at our camp include: Youth Activity Coordinators (YACs), Recreation Staff, Counsellors, and a Camp Nurse.



Registration is \$550 per camper (\$650 for non-affiliates). Full payment must accompany completed registration in order to qualify.

Some affiliated unions subsidize this cost – check with your union local. Arrangement for payment by the union is the responsibility of the camper's parent(s)/guardian(s).

Limited scholarships are available. Our goal is to ensure no one is excluded because of cost.

All campers, counsellors and camp staff must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
