

Overview: Wellbeing and Work

Covid-19 is taking a toll

More than four in ten say they are doing worse than two years ago, and few say they are doing better.

When it comes to work, close to half are struggling a little and finding it hard to cope some days, and **almost one in three** are having a great deal of difficulty.

Short-staffing is a major problem, with **close to half** reporting that it occurs almost daily.

When asked what is important to making their workplace a good place to work, more than half selected earning a good wage, and almost half selected workload/reasonable expectations of what can be done in a shift.




General Wellbeing

Just under half (44%) say they are doing worse than they were two years ago, and only 9% say they are doing better.

(percentage selected)




Q1. In general, would you say you and your family are doing better or worse compared to 2 years ago? N=812

Coping with Workplace Stress

Where close to half are struggling a little and finding it hard to cope some days, almost one in three (32%) are having a great deal of difficulty, compared with only one in five who say they are managing well.

(percentage selected)




Q2. Now, thinking about workplace stress, what comes closest to how you are coping? N=812

Issues at Work: Hours and Staffing

Short-staffing is a major problem, with close to half reporting that it occurs almost daily. More than half report that short staffing affects quality of care once a week or more often, and nearly half report being asked to work overtime once a week or more, compared to only 8% who did not get enough hours once a month or more.

 ■ Not applicable





Effects of Pandemic

More than half (54%) report they are now very likely or somewhat likely to find a job doing something different due to the pandemic. Almost half (44%) said that compared to before the pandemic, they are very likely or somewhat likely to leave their current job but stay in the same profession. A smaller number were likely to retire altogether, reduce their hours, or increase their hours.
